Dr Melanie Lovatt is a senior lecturer in sociology at the University of Stirling. Her research interests focus on ageing and time. Her most recent project 'Reimagining the Future in Older Age' (<a href="https://reimaginingthefutureinolderage.stir.ac.uk/">https://reimaginingthefutureinolderage.stir.ac.uk/</a>) used fiction and forum theatre techniques to explore the relationship between future time and later life. Key ideas that informed this project concerned what we *desire* and not just *need* as we age, the meaning that comes with increasing proximity to finitude, and the value of creative and arts-based methods to enhancing social scientists' understanding of older age.
