

Dr Sarah Hopkins is a British Geriatrics Society and The Dunhill Medical Trust Doctoral Clinical Fellow and a Specialty Registrar in Geriatric and General Internal Medicine. Her research centres around improving care for older frailer people, their families and informal carers.
